Dear Mr. Ndlovu, AMD and Donors

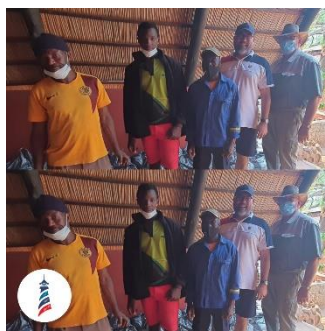
What an exciting year it has been so far and all thanks to passionate donors such as yourself. You are indeed contributing South African citizens & companies who cares about those in need.

We were privileged to assist and facilitate your outreach to KZN. We wish to thank you, the South African Aerospace, Maritime & Defence force Association, for trusting us and allowing us the opportunity to reach out to KZN. With this outreach we assisted those in need with 1097 food parcels. On the 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2021 we targeted the Shemula area which is approximately 45km north of Jozini. This area is also the second poorest area per capita in South Africa. Here we handed out 697 food parcels. Beneficiaries as far as St. Lucia, Matubatuba, and Manguzi benefitted from this donation. Approximately 2788 individuals including orphans and the elderly benefitted from the food parcels. These parcels were handed to community leaders who distributed it in turn to those most in need.

On the 29<sup>th</sup> of September 2021 we handed out 300 parcels in the Durban and Pietermaritzburg area to military veterans as per the request of AMD. We had rain in Pietermaritzburg and were drenched after handing out the parcels. The weather was kind to us in Durban which allowed my colleagues the opportunity to say a prayer of thanks, for the parcels, together with all the beneficiaries when the handover took place.

The food parcels consisted of the following:

2.5kg maize meal, 500ml oil, 1kg cake flour, 2kg brown sugar, 1kg samp, 2kg rice, 1 x pilchards 410g, 100 tea bags, 50g instant soup, 65g noodles, 500g soya mince, 400g spaghetti, 100g coffee, Biscuits-125g.

At LCC then, just in short then, YTD we were able to provide shelter services, emergency accommodation and accompanying in-house services to 148 individuals. 47 have been placed in drug rehabilitation centres, 14 were reunited with their families, 25 received full time employment and 2 were transferred specialized facilities for the elderly. We were also able to provide the following meals and food parcels (excl. that of the AMD):



Some success stories were that of Gary & Vicky who were reunited with their children after Gary lost his job and turned to drinking. Gary is now sober after completing our in-house anti addiction programs. We have also assisted him to renew his Psira security registration. Gary started working at Crime Stop Security Company on 22 September 2021. They have also been reunited with their children who were placed in a children's home due to him being unemployed and drinking excessively.

We have numerous success stories, however I would like to also share the story of Henry. Henry came into LCC as a drug user and a practiser of dark arts. Henry is also a father of a 7 year old boy. For the past 2 years there were no contact between him and his son. After numerous therapy and counselling sessions, both psychological and spiritual, Henry has been sober now for 7 months and has left all his dark ways. Through assistance of our social workers he has also been reconciled with his son and will start his new job as a boiler maker on 4 October 2021. Below is a photo of their first meeting after 2 years at our RVLTN coffee shop in Heidelberg.



We could also donate blankets to many organisations and individuals in and around Heidelberg during winter time. The blanket donees included the Ratanda Old Age Home, Suikerbosrand Old Age Home and a centre for 72 mentally disabled adults. Many individuals in and around the Lesedi Municipal area also received blankets.
